

Ordinance #2015-02

TOWN OF RUSK, RUSK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

REDUCED SPEED LIMIT — DEER HEAD POINT ROAD

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Rusk, Rusk County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under Wisc. §349.11 to adopt this ordinance, which provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the Town of Rusk as follows:

- a) Chapter 346, Wisc. Statutes allows towns to reduce the speed limit to thirty-five (35) miles per hour on any town road where, on either side of the highway within any one-thousand (1,000) feet along such highway, the buildings in use for business, industrial or residential purposes fronting thereon average less than one hundred-fifty (150) feet apart.
- b) Thereby, pursuant to Wisc. §346, the speed limit on Deer Head Point Road in the Town of Rusk, is reduced to 35 miles per hour.
- c) No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted portion of Deer Head Point Road in violation of this speed limit. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under Wisc. §346.60.
- d) Pursuant to Wisc. §349.11(5), the town chairman (or her designee) shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.



This ordinance is effective on posting.


