

RESOLUTION 2016 - 4

The Town Board of the Town of Rusk, Rusk County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

A public hearing to discuss a proposed action to discontinue a public way in the Town of Rusk shall be held as provided in accordance with the following Notice of Hearing.

The town clerk shall publish the following Notice of Hearing as a class 3 notice under chapter 985, Wis. stats., and the town clerk shall cause the Notice of Hearing to be served on the owners of all of the frontage of lots and lands abutting upon the public way sought to be discontinued in the manner provided for the service of summons in circuit court at least 30 days before the hearing, except that when service cannot be made within the town, a copy of the notice shall be mailed to the owner's last-known address at least 30 days before the hearing:


A public hearing will held be held by the Town Board of the Town of Rusk at the Rusk Town Hall located at N704 County Hwy F Chetek WI 54728, on Thursday May 12, 2016, at 6:45p.m., to discuss a proposed action to commence discontinuance of the following described town road initiated by petition under s. 66.1003 (2), Wis. stats., to the Town of Rusk specifically:

All that portion of Heather Lane as shown on the Plat of A. L. Aldila Subdivision No. 1 lying North of Lot Four (4) and East of Lot Five (5).

The town clerk shall file in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Rusk County, Wisconsin, a lis pendens related to the proposed discontinuance of public way.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
